The selection process of civil society representatives in the Council on Implementation of the Government Strategy for cooperation with civil society

Civil society representatives in the Council on Implementation of the Government Strategy for cooperation with civil society will be nominated and elected by civil society organizations and the entire process will be organized by the CiviKos Platform in cooperation with the Office on Good Governance within the Office of the Prime Minister (OGG/OPM). Civil society shall be represented in the Council by fifteen representatives, of whom one is appointed by the CiviKos Platform, while fourteen others are selected from the civil society organizations themselves.

The selection process will seek to provide a balance between:

- 1. Representation** - by enabling CSOs to nominate candidates among them or in other CSO sectors and encouraging the nomination of women, members of minority communities, and marginalized groups.
- 2. Expertise** - by defining the basic criteria that should be met by the nominee as well as the nominee by CSOs.

The main criterion for the nominee determines that the nominee should have proven working experience in a certain field and be engaged in a CSO that has been profiled in the concerned sector for the past three years.

The main criterion nominee (CSO's as the nominee) determines that CSOs are to be founded for at least the past three years.

All nomination and selection procedure is organized by the Secretariat of the CiviKos Platform through nomination and voting forms that clearly define all the required conditions and additional documents needed. A vetting panel composed of one representative of the Secretariat of the CiviKos Platform, one member of the CiviKos Board, and one representative of the OGG/OPM will confirm meeting of criteria of the nominee

before formalization of the final voting list. The right to vote for the nominees is to have all the OSCs registered under the Law on Freedom of Association in NGOs.
